Cookie policy

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer when you visit a website. This allows this website to remember your actions and preferences (such as language, font, display options, etc.) for a certain period of time. The advantage of this is that when you revisit the website or navigate between different web pages, your preferences do not have to be chosen and set over and over again.

Cookies are used to facilitate and improve the surfing experience. When you visit the website, cookies ensure that your personal settings are recalled. In addition, data is collected on how the website was consulted, enabling us to improve the overall performance of the website in terms of speed and operation.

Cookies never function independently and are always linked to a website. Cookies do not in any way provide access to data on your computer or telephone.

If you do not want a website to place cookies on your computer, you can change your browser settings accordingly.

What types of cookies does Thalentio® use?
